Design of Exercises for PGDM-II Induction

Design of Exercise 1

Objectives:

- □ To share the experiences of Summer Internship.
- □ To help students deal with perceptions of Work Organizations

Random groups are formed with a faculty member facilitating each group. After the groups are formed:

- > Students one by one share their experience of the organization in terms of the following:
 - 1. People at the work place
 - 2. Industry to which the organization belongs
 - 3. products sold
 - 4. customers
 - 5. use of technology
- > Each student then lists at least two positive and two negative features of the organization
- ➤ The faculty member then collates the experiences of the group.

Design of Exercise 2

Objectives:

- 1. To recapitulate the 'learning' from the period of the summer internship.
- 2. To share the 'learning' and see the relevance of the learning for the year ahead.

Groups are formed with a faculty member facilitating each group Trigger:

- Recall the activities or things that you did in the last 2 months, in which you feel you put in a lot of energy and efforts. These need not be only from your internship, they could be in any field of personal life. Describe what you did in detail. Share it in the group.
- Go over the description again and think of what you learnt from these activities. See if you developed any capacity as a result of putting in a lot of efforts in these activities. Describe whatever capacity you developed and share it in the group.
- All groups reassemble on an online platform. A representative of each group would make a small presentation to the class on the learning.
- Faculty members share their reflections

Guidelines for faculty:

• Students should be encouraged to think of themselves as a bundle of transferable skills, which can be used in a variety of jobs. Faculty member should help students to identify skills developed in the course of their internship
